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### Market Value & Asset Allocation:

The Total Fund market value increased by \$326 million in July and finished the month at \$14.4 billion. The PERA Board updated the strategic asset allocation (SAA) in April 2016. PERA's SAA is 43.5% Global Equity, 21.5% Risk Reduction and Mitigation, 15.0% Credit Oriented Fixed Income, and 20% Real Assets. Based on current market values, excluding the cash overlay, Global Equity is 11.5% overweight and Risk Reduction and Mitigation is overweight by 6.5%, which are both outside of the policy range. Credit Oriented Fixed Income is 7.3% underweight and Real Assets is underweight by 11.5%, which are both outside of policy range. The Board and Staff are working on an implementation plan for the new SAA. Per section IV. A., Strategic Asset Allocation Targets, of the Investment Policy, "The Board recognizes that the long-term target allocation may take an extended period to implement."

### Asset Transfers:

PERA transferred \$49 million at month-end from the cash account to the PERA STO account for beneficiary payments and operating expenses. For the fiscal year, PERA has transferred \$49 million to the PERA fund, \$0.2 million to the Magistrates account, \$0.3 million to the Judicial account and \$0.2 million to the Volunteer Fire Fighter account. Private partnerships called \$28 million and distributed \$13 million during the month. For last fiscal year capital calls averaged \$39 million per month and totaled \$469 million while distributions averaged \$23 million per month and totaled \$270 million.

### Fund Returns & Performance:

The Total Fund returned 2.69%, net of fees, for the month. The Global Equity custom benchmark returned 3.15%, the Risk Reduction and Mitigation benchmark returned 0.62%, the Credit Oriented Fixed Income benchmark returned 2.32%, and the Real Assets benchmark returned 0.32%. The Fund has returned 2.69% for the fiscal year and 6.10% for the 3-year period.

### Watch List Update:

None of PERA's active Global Public Equity or Fixed Income managers are on the Watch List. Four of PERA's alternative investments are also on Cliffwater's Watch List.
